

Literacy

In this term we will be looking at a range of books from the same author. We will be looking at, Julia Donaldson, Rachel Bright and Oliver Jeffers. When reading the books from the above authors we will be focusing on the similarities between each book. We will be writing character descriptions, using adjectives. Currently in phonics we are consolidating our learning within phase 4.

Mathematics

In maths this term we will be exploring the composition of odd and even numbers and looking at the shape of the numbers that are odd and even. Children will link odd and even number sorting to the concept of sharing. We will begin to link even numbers to doubles and explore the composition of numbers within 10. To further our knowledge of addition and subtraction we will solve mathematical problems within these equations by identify missing numbers in the counting sequence.

Expressive Arts and Design

Children will be creating story scenes using different textures, using different types of paper/straws/string. Children will have an option to create a story setting from any of the above authors. Children will be exposed to various art materials that will allow them to create a story setting of their choice.

Communication and Language

Our new topic covers many aspects of communication, children will have opportunities stories and what is happening and what might happen next. Children will be able to use the range of vocabulary they have been exposed to, by retelling stories they have heard. We will be talking about what 'empathy' means and what it feels like and think about ways that we can support each other. We will be using our speaking and listening skills for our building area outside and in our construction area. Children will follow instructions and negotiate with each other how to complete a task, listening very carefully to each other and to take turns in the conversations.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be listening to stories about different worries and talking about any worries or concerns that they may have with going into year 1.

Our new topic in our 'SCARF' programme this term is 'Growing and Changing'. We will be looking the stages and changes of animals, plants and humans. We will also be covering, where babies come from, getting bigger and about different bodies.

Understanding the World

This term in Understanding the world, children will be focusing on geography. We will be learning all about our local area and comparing to other geographic areas. Children will have the opportunity to discuss the similarities and differences in their own local area to somewhere they may have been on holiday. Children will be looking at and discussing the features of the world map.

Children will also carry out different experiments to test which materials float and sink, linking with the stories we will be covering within class.

In ICT children will be learning all about pictograms and how they are created and what they show.

Physical Development

Our focus in physical development this term will be to focus on learning new games and looking at different ball skills. Children will then use their knowledge of ball skills in the game taught. This term children will participate in 'sports day' where children will use their PE skills to complete various sporting games.

During our sessions, children will discuss healthy and not healthy foods. To further their knowledge children will look at what they need to do to make their bodies move to stay healthy.
