

History/ Geography

This term in History we will be looking at and comparing the Stone, Bronze and Iron Age periods. Using information pupils will create chronological time lines and fact files. We will also investigate dwellings and discover how humans survived the Stone Age. In addition to this we will study the life and work of English paleontologist Mary Anning.

ICT

We will be exploring networks and computer systems to expand our knowledge of how computers work.

PSHE

Using the SCARF program of study our unit will be "Me and My Relationships" focusing on how to have positive friendships.

English

Our focus story will be "Stone Age boy" and our inspiration to write our own retell of the narrative. We will consolidate our understanding of sentence structure, punctuation and the use of apostrophes. We will continue to improve our spelling of High Frequency words. Our whole class reading text will be "Stig of the Dump".

RE

Our main focus will be the Creation story and thinking about what Christians learn from this. We will continue to widen our knowledge of this story by learning about the first sin and how this is reflected in Christianity today.

Maths

We begin with extending our understanding of place value and numbers with pupils working with numbers up to 1000. In addition to this we will consolidate our addition and subtraction skills and will develop our recall of multiplication tables.

PE

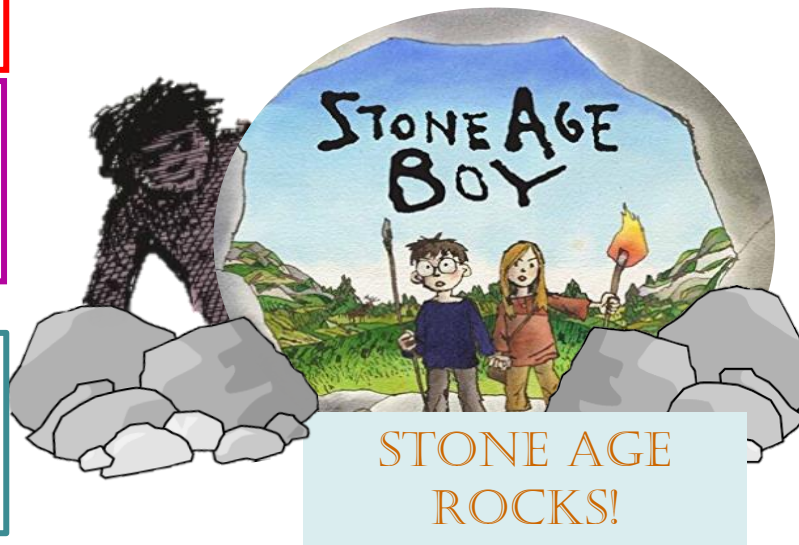
In PE we will focusing on our hand-eye co-ordination and racket skills whilst playing tennis.

We will be introduced to how to read music through simple notation which will enable us to play simple pieces of music on tuned and percussion instruments.

Art/DT

We will re-create techniques used in the Stone Age to create cave paintings and even make our own paint! We will also be improving our sketching skills and learn how to scale up our creations.

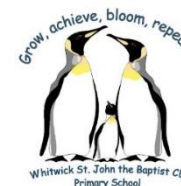


MFL
